Colonel Timothy J. Madden is the Commander of the 149th Fighter Wing, Joint Base San Antonio-Lackland, Texas. He's responsible for providing the finest combat F-16 fighter pilots and combat support personnel for worldwide operations. The 149th Fighter Wing is home to the 149th Maintenance Group, 149th Operations Group, 149th Mission Support Group and the 149th Medical Group. In addition, the 149th has four geographically separated units: Texas Air National Guard Headquarters, 204th Security Forces Squadron, 209th Weather Flight, and the 273rd Information Operations Squadron.



Colonel Madden entered the Air Force in 1988 after completing Air Force ROTC at the University of Maryland with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Criminal Justice. He attended pilot training at Columbus AFB, Mississippi. In 1990, he attended Lead-In Fighter Training at Holloman AFB before going to MacDill AFB for F-16C replacement training. Colonel Madden graduated from pilot training in 1990, and is a command pilot with more than 4,000 total flying hours and 697 combat hours. In 1999, he became Chief Weapons and Tactics with 55th Fighter Squadron, Shaw AFB, South Carolina. In 2013, he was chosen as to be the Air National Guard Advisor to the United States Air Force Warcenter commander, Nellis AFB, Nevada on matters pertaining to the Nevada Air Guard's resources and activities and issues related to total force integration and civil aviation activities.

Colonel Madden has served as a weapons school instructor, director of operations, fighter squadron commander and deputy operations group commander. He deployed on 11 Air Expeditionary Force deployments with his last as the 121st Expeditionary Squadron Commander as the first Air National Guard F-16 unit to Bagram Air Base Afghanistan.
