 - 4. The grant is for up to \$500, not automatically \$500.
 - 5. This grant will be open for approximately two weeks.

Eligibility includes:

- Active duty Air Force members
- Air National Guard or Air Force Reserve personnel on extended active duty over 15 days under Title 10, USC (assistance is limited to emergencies incidental to, or resulting from applicant's active duty tour)
- Air National Guard personnel on Title 32 USC 502(f) Full-Time Active Guard Reserve (ANG) orders (Initial & Continuation Tour Only)
